### **Question 1**

- a) Husband and wife established a law firm and are currently operating as equal partners.

- c) Two weeks later the client had not been paid prompting the client to approach the wife to enquire about the late payment alleging the husband had not made the payment.
- d) The wife became suspicious and approached the husband requesting access to the trust account and the husband assured her that everything was under control and she needs not concern herself with the trust account.
- e) The wife stopped pursuing the issue only to discover a few weeks down the line that the client had not been paid and had approached the Law Society of Zimbabwe in a bid to recover her money.
- f) The Law Society has since escalated the issue to the disciplinary tribunal.

- a) T and M Legal Practitioners operate a business current, a business savings, a trust current as well as a trust savings account. On 10 November 2021 they withdrew a sum of \$20 000 from the trust savings account being interest earned which amount they then deposited into their business current account.
- b) The financial year end of D and H Legal Practitioners was the 30 April 2021. The annual audit was completed on 30 May 2021 and the audit certificate was submitted to the Law Society on 15 October 2021.
